

Scholarships Available to Troy High School Seniors

Altrusa Club of Troy Scholarship

This scholarship is available to a Troy High School **senior girl who is a member of ASTRA Club** and will be attending a 2 or 4 year accredited college, university or technical school. Selection will be based on service to the community in addition to academics. Applications are available through the high school guidance office.
